DROP OF ALL STANDARD DEFINITION MPEG-2 SIGNALS

Phase 3 MPEG-2 to MPEG-4 Transition to begin April 2019

In April 2019 we will begin to drop MPEG-2 standard definition signals from our satellites. The drop of the MPEG-2 signals will continue for several months; details are available on our website. By Fall 2019 we will have a primarily all MPEG-4 high definition offering with some MPEG-4 standard definition signals.

To make the transition as smooth as possible we encourage customers to start launching the MPEG-4 signals as soon as possible. Please don't wait for the MPEG-2 version of the signal to drop from the satellite. We can not delay any of the signals being dropped so it is imperative that you are prepared in advance.
